



## “Street of the Week”

## Neighborhood Program

Police visibility discourages bad behavior. Criminals usually avoid executing their plans if there is a police presence in the area. Thus patrol activity should be carried in a manner that attracts maximum attention to the police. This theory applies the principle of proactive community policing. As Bloomingtondale is a town with many residential side streets, it is important to include street patrols on all the streets, irrespective of the percentages in “calls for service”. With this being said, Bloomingtondale is proud to implement the “Street of the Week” neighborhood program.

The program “Street of the Week” entails a complaint form in which residents will address problems located in their neighborhood. Complaint forms can be located at the Bloomingtondale Police Headquarters and will soon be available online. Once completed, the form can be mailed back to or dropped off at the Bloomingtondale Police Department. This complaint form will be reviewed by our officers regarding quality of life issues and other concerns pertaining to the safety of our community. After the complaint is reviewed, a designated officer will form and prepare an action plan for each street chosen.

Once a street has been selected within the borough it will be patrolled frequently by police officers. Issues or concerns observed by patrols will be documented and forwarded to the appropriate officer for review.

In keeping with the desire to provide a safe atmosphere in ALL residential areas, officers will emphasize a high profile, mobile and interactive approach to the selected area. The goal of the program will address any complaints received and ultimately lead to increased citizen confidence in the Bloomingtondale Police Department.

We encourage all residents to turn in their “Street of the Week” complaint forms in hope to provide a proactive response to the quality of life in the Borough of Bloomingtondale.
